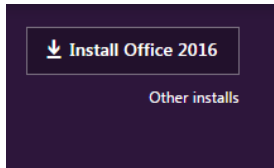


Office 365 Pro Plus 2013 on Five Devices

To get started, log in to your O365 Microsoft account here <https://login.microsoftonline.com/>

1. If you are currently using Office 2013 and do not wish to upgrade to Office 2016, select “Other Installs”.



2. Scroll down to Office 365 Pro Plus 2013.
3. Click the dropdown button and choose the default installation at 32-bit or select 64-bit.
